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Rosacea is one of the most common skin diseases whose frequency has been increasing in recent years. The disease not only causes cosmetic problems but also affects the quality of life due to redness flare-ups. There are many factors involved in the pathogenesis of the disease. Ultraviolet radiation and the Demodex parasite, in particular, are among the most important factors. The increasing density of Demodex, particularly due to the effects of global warming and the pandemic, contributes to the exacerbation of the disease. The disease follows a chronic course, and treatment options are gradually increasing. Medical treatment alone is often not sufficient, and in most cases, lasers and light systems are needed to address erythema and telangiectasia. Additionally, patients must be protected from factors that exacerbate the disease. Continuing treatment after the active treatment phase is crucial in reducing disease relapses.

This book is the first to be written on the topic of rosacea in our country. A total of 26 topics have been prepared in two sections, Diagnosis and Treatment, with the valuable contributions of our authors, most of whom are members of the Turkish Dermatology Society's Acne and Rosacea Study Group. These chapters provide up-to-date approaches and advanced information on treatments. We hope that our book will serve as an updated guide for dermatology residents and specialists for daily practice and clinical research.
