The first meeting was held last year in Ankara and the topic was congenital hyperinsulinism. We found the opportunity to discuss and share experiences with a well known expert in this field.

The Current Trends meetings was planned originally to discuss clinical problems in various topics in Pediatric Endocrinology with the most experienced authors, specialists in the field. This year's theme was growth problems and their management. We started with the evolution of body size and continued with idiopathic short stature. Growth hormone treatment in childhood intracranial tumors is a debatable issue that we face in our daily practice. In this meeting the results of GH treatment in Turkish children with intracranial tumors were discussed and cases with various tumors were presented and also the literature was reviewed by one of the well known experts on this field.

Finally we would like to thank all speakers, participants who contributed to this exciting scientific meeting and Sandoz company for making this possible.
